

The City of Corning would like to make commercial property owners aware of newly established rules which require carbon monoxide detectors in all commercial buildings.

The New York State Department of State has adopted a rule that amends the Uniform Code by adding provisions applicable to carbon monoxide alarms in commercial buildings.

Carbon monoxide detectors must be installed in all new commercial buildings. Carbon monoxide detectors must also be installed in all existing commercial buildings by June 27, 2016. To comply with this new rule, building owners need to submit plans for the installation of their carbon monoxide detection systems to the City's Code Enforcement Office for review and obtain a building permit. Employing a design professional is encouraged.
