



Building Code Effectiveness Grading Schedule

The Building Code Effectiveness Grading Schedule (BCEGS) helps identify communities that are more resilient to natural hazards and everyday perils. The City of Corning receives a BCEGS grading from the Insurance Services Office, Inc. (ISO).

The BCEGS program evaluates building code enforcement efforts at the jurisdiction level in three areas: code administration, plan review, and field inspection. ISO rates communities from 1 (exemplary commitment to building code enforcement) to 10 (lowest commitment to building code enforcement). The City of Corning has a BCEGS classification of 2 for 1 and 2 family residential properties and 2 for commercial and industrial properties.

BCEGS classifications are currently part of the criteria for receiving discounted flood insurance premiums from the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) through the Community Rating System (CRIS) program.
