



## **Canfield Park Walking Trail**

Canfield Park is located within the Southside Historic District of the City of Corning. The District is included on the U.S. Department of Interior's National Register of Historic Places. The park dates to the early 20<sup>th</sup> Century and is considered to be a "contributing" park to the historical significance of the City's Southside Neighborhood.

Working with the Southside Neighborhood Association and the Crystal City Parks Foundation, the City of Corning underwent the first phase of restoration on Canfield Park. This restoration included grading and drainage improvements, restoration of a network of crushed stone paths, installations of benches, and landscaping. This project was completed in July 2017. By using crushed stone, rather than impervious pavement, the City improved water runoff and reduced the heat signature of the paths.

This project helped revitalize the adjacent commercial and residential areas by increasing walkability for residents and visitors of the park. This project also demonstrates environmental improvements to the scenic and ecological qualities of the City.
