



Curbside Leaf Collection

The City provides curbside leaf collection each Fall season to reduce the amount of leaves being disposed at the County's landfill and to keep storm sewer systems clear.

Each year, Department of Public Works crews will begin picking up loose leaves near the end of October. Bagged leaf collection service follows loose leaf collection. It usually begins the Monday after loose leaf collection ends and will continue through mid-December. The exact dates of loose and bagged leaf collection are released through public service announcements in the media and can be found on the City website homepage under "Notices" during the Fall season.

Through its curbside collection programs, the City collects approximately 1,000 cubic yards of leaves on an annual basis, which is mulched at the City's yard waste site on Route 414. The mulch is then made available free of charge to residents during the yard waste site's seasonal operations.

To complement collection efforts, the City encourages residents to mulch leaves in their back yards.
