



### Fleet Reduction

The City owns various vehicles to conduct its daily operations. Excluding heavy equipment such as loaders, backhoes, and street sweepers, the fleet include vehicles such as fire apparatus, passenger vehicles, police cruisers, pickup trucks, plow & dump trucks, a sewer jet, garbage trucks, a recycling truck, and a bucket truck. The fleet is maintained by a combination of the City's Fleet Division and outside maintenance specialists.

Since 1997, the City has reduced the size of its fleet to provide for more efficient operations. The total size of the fleet in 1997 compared to 2019 is as follows:
