

Report of the Housing Strategy Committee

City Council Regular meeting, October 7, 2013.

At the September 19, 2013 meeting of the Housing Strategy Committee meeting a motion was passed to recommend to the City Manager the retention of the company Fairweather/Clough Harbor to conduct the City of Corning Housing Strategy Study.

The cost as proposed was \$44,750. This is subject to additional negotiation as to scope of work.

The City Manager and the Director of Economic Development met with Fairweather/Clough Harbor and are in the process of hiring them.
