The City of Corning has approximately 400 fire hydrants. During winter storms, we are looking for the public's help keeping them clear of snow.

Time spent by firefighters locating and clearing snow from a buried fire hydrant could be costly. As the snow begins to pile up please take a few moments to clear the snow around nearby fire hydrants. Clear at least three feet around the hydrant to allow firefighters to work.

Fire spreads at a rapid rate. Time is critical to controlling the damage and risk to the public.
