



PARKING

Parking regulations are enforced by the Police Department. Residents and visitors should be aware of the following regulations regarding on street parking:

ALTERNATE SIDE STREET PARKING. On Street Parking in the City is as follows unless otherwise posted:

Even Side of the Street:

NO PARKING 12:01 am - 4:00 pm on Monday, Wednesday, Friday, Sunday

Odd Side of the Street:

NO PARKING 12:01 am - 4:00 pm on Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday

ZONE PARKING:

In and around the business district, the City uses Zone Parking. Parking is limited to two hours per zone per day. The time in the zone begins when the vehicle first parks and is continuous from that point even if the vehicle leaves within the two hour period.

Zone 1: Market Street from Wall Street to Pine Street

Zone 2: Market Street from Pine Street to Chestnut Street

Zone 3: Market Street from Chestnut Street to Bridge Street

Zone 4: Bridge Street from Pulteney Street to Riverside Drive

Zone 5: Bridge Street from Pulteney Street to Jennings Street

OFF STREET PARKING:

Parking is available in several City Lots. Some lots require a minimal fee for parking and each lot is posted with instructions and rates. A free parking lot is available on the South side of Denison Parkway next to McDonalds at Chestnut Street. A limited number of parking permits are available for City lots. The City also owns a parking garage that is operated by the Gaffer District. It is located on Tioga Avenue behind the Clock Tower.

HANDICAP SPACES:

Parking in a reserved Handicap space requires a valid permit AND the vehicle must be in use by the holder of the permit.

ALLEYS AND LANES:

Parking is prohibited in all alleys and lanes.

Parking ticket fines double if they are not paid within 14 days. An arrest warrant may be issued to the owner of the vehicle and/or the vehicle registration may be suspended if fines go unanswered.

PARKING OVER 24 HOURS PROHIBITED:

No person shall park any vehicle upon any street or parts of streets or any City-of-Corning-controlled parking lot or parking area for a period of more than 24 consecutive hours.

Parking tickets may be paid on-line at www.parkingticketpayment.com/corning. Tickets may be protested by completing a protest form in the Finance Office located in City Hall, Monday - Friday, 8:30 am - 3:30 pm.
