



Novel Corona Virus March 16, 2020

In an effort to help control the spread of the Novel Corona Virus, the City Manager has taken the following actions today:

- Cancelled the public information meeting the City was planning to hold tonight concerning Pathway's intention to develop a community residential home at 47 East Spruce Street.
- Cancelled the Senior Citizens bus trip scheduled for March 30, 2020.
- Cancelled the Recreation Department's Spring Break Activity that was scheduled for April 6-9, 2020.
- Cancelled the Parks Open House that was scheduled for April 13, 2020.
- Requested all City committees, boards and commissions only meet if they need to address higher priority actions.
- Cancelled all meetings being held by outside groups in City facilities.

The City Manager had previously ordered the closure of the Corning Senior Center effective Friday, March 13, 2020 until further notice.
