



Scrap Metal

The City of Corning's operations produce various types of scrap metals, such as street signs, posts, angle iron, piping, light fixtures, failed equipment, and failed vehicle parts. Some of these metals include copper, steel, aluminum, brass, and iron. The City recycles approximately 14,000 pounds of scrap metal per year.

Recycling scrap metal reduces waste being disposed at landfills and saves energy used to produce new materials.
